

New Member Dues Payments – First & Second Years of Membership

Background:

Some new members join without hesitation and pay full dues. Others consider joining by getting a “taste of Bet Aviv” membership and choose our “Pay from Your Heart Option.” The following addresses how much in dues is to be paid in years 1 and 2 depending upon when in the first year that they join and under which option. Beyond years 1 and 2 of membership, normal dues policies apply.

Option A. New Members Who Choose to Pay Regular Dues Upon Joining: This Basic Dues Schedule is most suitable for new members who have made the decision to join Bet Aviv and pay full regular dues without the Pay from Your Heart option.

New members joining from January 1 to May 31 pay full dues in their first and second years. Those joining from May 31 to Rosh Hashanah pay half dues their first year and full dues starting in their second year. Those joining from Rosh Hashanah to the end of the year would pay full dues upon joining for a period which covers through December 31 of the following year. They would get up to 16 months’ worth of membership benefits – one time.

Option B. New Members Who Choose the Pay from Your Heart Option (previously approved by the Board): This option is most suitable for those who are interested but hesitant and would like a “taste of Bet Aviv” membership before paying full dues.

This allows “hesitant” prospective members to pay less than full dues (one time only) the year that they join while “experiencing Bet Aviv.” Those joining from January 1 until Rosh Hashanah “pay from their heart” for this first year and pay full dues for their second year and beyond. Those joining from Rosh Hashanah to the end of the year would “pay from their heart” upon joining for a period which covers through December 31 of the following year. They would get up to 16 months’ worth of membership benefits – one time.
