The first major film documentary to cover the performer's career and his quest for identity. He strove to achieve the American dream at a time of racial prejudice and shifting political territory. He was the most public Black figure at that time to embrace Judaism.

*(2017) Arabic/Hebrew/English/Italian/French with English subtitles, 81 minutes*

A Christian Arab who is a failing businessman in Nazareth dreams of success by selling the air of the Holy Land. To bring such a product to market, he needs the cooperation of three cultures ruling over Nazareth: the Jewish politicians, the Muslim mafia, and the Catholic Church officials.
